

Tips for Using Search

Can't find what you're looking for? Give these tips a try!

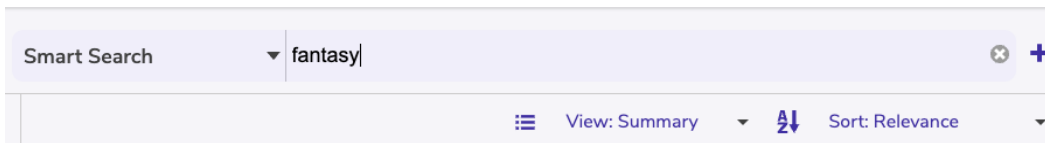
Check your spelling and use fewer words

Make sure you're spelling your search term correctly and use fewer words.

Use unique words

Try using the most unique word(s) in the title you're looking for.

Set Search Type before searching

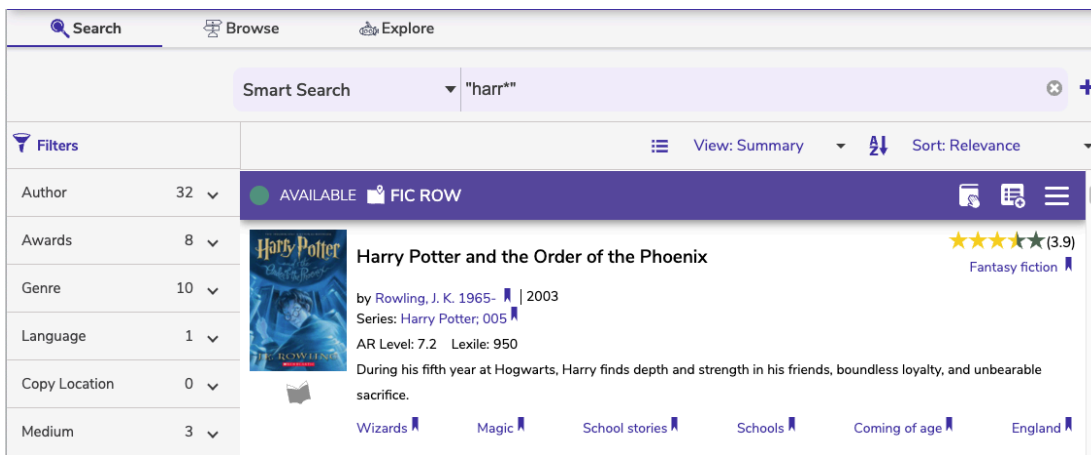


Use Sort and Filter after searching

Change how the results are ordered or filter by author, genre, series, and more.

Try a “begins-with” search

If you're not sure how to spell your search term, add quotes and an asterisk to the first part of your term ("term*"), or use the spellcheck “did you mean...” dropdown.



Search by title and author

Having trouble finding a book with a common title, such as *It*? Search by title and author (e.g. "it stephen king") to get more accurate results.

Use Advanced Search

If you need something really specific, use Advanced Search. This will let you enter multiple search terms with AND, OR, or AND NOT.
